2011 Scholarship Application For students enrolled in Wisconsin's Technical Colleges

Purpose: In order to promote agricultural consulting as a profession that is important to the economy and environment in Wisconsin and to advance the science of agriculture in general, the Wisconsin Association of Professional Agricultural Consultants (WAPAC) has established a scholarship program for students enrolled in a production oriented and/or applied research (crop or livestock) degree program.

Amount of Scholarship: One \$500 scholarships will be awarded in 2011.

Deadline for Application: November 1, 2011. Scholarship recipients will be notified by mid December.

Qualifications:

- Eligible students must be currently enrolled as a full time student and must have career goals that would benefit significantly from participating in an internship related to production agriculture or applied research. Students pursuing associate degrees (or other certification programs) in the production agriculture sciences (crop and/or livestock) are preferred
- The student must have been enrolled the previous summer in an internship or job that was directly related to production agriculture.
- This scholarship is based on merit and not on financial need. A WAPAC Scholarship award may only be given to an individual only one time.

Application Procedure: Interested students can obtain an application form from their scholarship coordinator, from the from Bryan Jensen (bmjense1@facstaff.wisc.edu) or from the WAPAC website <http://www.wapac.info>

Additionally, students must obtain a written letter of recommendation from their employer. The letter of recommendation can either be submitted with the scholarship application or mailed under separate cover from the employer. Mail one copy of all relevant materials (application, official grade transcript or a clear and easily readable unofficial copy of grade transcript & letter of recommendation) by the November 11, 2011 deadline to:
